PURPOSE OF CIRCULAR:

To advise the appropriate departments and law enforcement agencies that as of September 4, 2001, the Motor Carrier Commission has redesigned the look of Motor Carrier Certificates (MV 5014).

The redesigned certificates are printed on 8.5" x 11" stationary instead of the 8"x 3.5" stationary. For security reasons, the new certificate has a government logo watermark on one side. The pre-printed information on the certificate will remain the same, but will be printed only on the watermark side on the stationary.

Please note the following: The watermark on the stationary is heat activated. During testing it was discovered that the heat activation is very sensitive. When placed in a hot vehicle the watermark disappeared but will reappear when removed from the vehicle. This feature prevents the document from being photocopied.

The original certificate must be carried in the licensed vehicle as Motor Carrier Act Regulation (B.C.Reg.252/94) – Part 6, Section 35 (3) states "every licensee must carry in the licensed vehicle the certificate which corresponds to the licence plate and decal displayed on the licensed vehicle."

Please also note that the current year's certificates issued prior to September 3, 2001, will remain valid until they expire on February 28, 2002.
