PURPOSE OF CIRCULAR:

To advise that the MV3073 Notice and Order has been revised and updated.

BACKGROUND:

The Commercial Vehicle Police Enforcement community (CVPE) identified a need to create an enforcement form that would allow more writing room so violations and warnings could accurately be described when being issued to commercial vehicle operators. A planning group was created with members from Vancouver, Abbotsford and RCM Police to review and develop possible solutions. It was decided the enforcement community did not need another form as there are already too many to carry around. It was decided the MV3073 Notice and Order could be modified which would allow it to be used for all traffic enforcement activities. Multi-vehicle combinations can now be sent in for inspection while issuing only one "piece of paper". It also allows for more writing room which the officer can use to accurately reflect defects or warnings. Over the past 12 months testing has occurred by many Police agencies with unanimous support for implementing the new form.

Attached is a copy of the new Notice and order, it will be available once the remainder of MV3073 Notice and Order stock is depleted.

Notice and Order MV3073 - BACK

COMPLIANCE INFORMATION

Do ONE of the following (as indicated (✓) on the reverse):

- 1 The vehicle is to be immediately removed from the highway and towed to a location of the operator's choice or place designated by the peace officer, at the operator's expense. It is to be kept from the highway until such time as it passes an inspection performed by an Authorized Inspector.
- 2 The vehicle described on the Notice and Order must be inspected promptly at a Designated Inspection Facility. Should it not comply with the Motor Vehicle Act and Regulations it must be repaired immediately and, within 30 days of this Notice, a passed inspection report completed by an Authorized Inspector must be submitted to the Insurance Corporation of British Columbia.

A valid inspection decal may be displayed on the vehicle. A copy of the inspection report should be kept with the vehicle for at least 12 months.

Locations of DESIGNATED INSPECTION FACILITIES can be obtained at a Driver Services Centre or Autoplan Agent.

NOTICE

The owner may choose not to have the vehicle inspected or repaired, but rather to surrender the vehicle licence and number plates to the Vice President, Operations, Insurance Corporation of British Columbia. Should the vehicle licence and number plates be surrendered or seized by a peace officer, the vehicle owner must make a separate application to ICBC or its agents for a refund.

It is the obligation of the registered owner to advise a subsequent registered owner of any outstanding vehicle inspection requirements.

- 3 Immediately correct the defect(s) or omission(s) noted and present this Notice and Order to a peace officer at the location indicated, within the time designated, verifying that the required defect(s) or omission(s) have been corrected.

WARNING

It is an offence to operate a vehicle which does not comply with the Motor Vehicle Act and Regulations or this Notice and Order. Failure to comply with this Notice and Order will result in the refusal of further vehicle licence transactions. Penalties for operating a vehicle in contravention of this Notice and Order include a \$500 fine and seizure of the vehicle licence and number plates.
