## SUBJECT: Introduction of Extended Length Semi-Trailers

## PURPOSE OF CIRCULAR


To notify staff and industry that CVSE has concluded a successful review and trial period for the operation of extended length semi-trailer combinations under permit in BC.

This extended semi-trailer length allowance gives carriers the benefit of transporting an increased amount of light-weight freight with fewer loads, while easing the congestion on our infrastructure and supporting a reduction in greenhouse gas emissions.

## **Extended Length Semi-Trailers:**

Single trip or term permits may be issued to operate tractor-semi-trailer combinations that include extended length semi-trailers with the following conditions:

- Semi-trailer maximum length extended to 18.5 m,
- Legal semi-trailer wheelbase (12.5 m) and rear projection (35% of wheelbase), and
- Tractor wheelbase minimum 5.0 m and maximum 5.5 m (single steer, single or tandem drive tractors only)
- Legal overall length for the combination (23 m).



## EXTENDED LENGTH TRACTOR SEMI-TRAILER COMBINATION

Permits for these dimensions are only issued for tractors and semi-trailers that in combination meet the above conditions; overweight permits are not available to these combinations.

A new permit policy for these extended length semi-trailer combinations can be found in **Section 5.3.7.F**, <u>Chapter 5</u> of the Commercial Transport Procedures Manual.
