To All Permit Issuers, Industry and the General Public

Amendment to Letters of Authorization for Short Logs, Long Logs and Wide Bunk Beetle Killed Wood:

This letter is to advise and notify the trucking industry of an amendment affecting operation under our Letters of Authorization for beetle-killed wood.

Where a valid Letter of Authorization indicates that any species of wood may be hauled from beetle-killed wood stands, it can now be deemed to mean that any species of wood from beetle-killed wood stands may be hauled from lumber mill to lumber mill; forest landing to lumber mill; lumber mill to/from log sort yard; and log sort yard to log sort yard.

<u>Note</u>: All other conditions still apply, in particular, routes listed on the appropriate T-Form for wide bunks.
