To All Permit Issuers, Industry, and the General Public

Oversize and Overweight Permit Restrictions for Travel on Highway 1 Between Hope and Spences Bridge

To Whom It May Concern:

Please be advised that effective immediately, the following oversize and overweight permit restrictions will be in place for travel on Highway 1 between Hope and Spences Bridge:

Hwy 1 between Boston Bar and Kanaka Bar:

- Vehicles/loads are limited to a maximum overall width of 3.8 m
- Vehicles/loads are limited to the weights found in the [Commercial Transport Regulations](#); overweight permits are not available.

These restrictions are necessary to ensure safe travel for all road users traveling along the impacted corridors as significant construction remains. The restrictions will be reviewed once repair work is complete.

Vehicles transporting equipment to flood impacted areas for response purposes may be eligible for an exception to the above restrictions.
