

Using Form CVSE1000

Form CVSE1000 replaces the T-53, T-53A and T-55. If you need information about permitting specific loads or vehicle types, you will find it in the Commercial Transport Procedures Manual, at <u>www.cvse.ca</u>. Look in Chapter 4 for Loads (Commodities), Chapter 5 for Vehicles, Chapter 6 for Heavy Haul and Chapter 7 for Letters of Authorization.

Note that the travel restrictions on Form CVSE1000 accumulate:

If your vehicle and load fall within all the dimension limits in Category A, you can travel in the Basic Travel Time Window for Category A and only the Category A Restrictions apply.

If one or more dimensions is too large for Category A, but they all fall within Category B, you can travel in the Basic Travel Time Window for Category B and follow the restrictions for Category A and Category B combined.

A + B + C and follow the restrictions for Category C, you can travel in the Basic Travel Time Window for Category C and follow the restrictions for Category A, Category B and Category C combined.

If one or more dimensions is too large

Requirements for pilot cars, flags, lamps, and signs are on Page 2 of this form.

There are two commodities that trigger a 'Page 3' to this form: Structures (CVSE1000S) and Logs (CVSE1000L)
